

Flagstaff Academy Policy Regarding Background Checks of Board Members:

The Academy shall require each prospective Board member to disclose, in advance of appointment, any incidents of unlawful sexual behavior by the prospective member involving a juvenile, regardless of whether criminal charges were filed, or any past criminal conviction punishable as a felony or related to misappropriation of funds or theft; and require each prospective and current Board member to promptly disclose any current arrest for a crime punishable as a felony or related to misappropriation of funds or theft. The Academy shall require each prospective Board member to acknowledge that failure to provide prompt and accurate disclosures is cause for removal from the Board. The Academy shall require each prospective Board member to submit their full name, social security number, and date of birth for purpose of a criminal background check conducted through the CBI web-based background-check service, and to consent to the disclosures provided for in this paragraph. The Academy shall complete the CBI web-based background check on each prospective board member. If the Academy's Board will vote on an appointment to the Board, the background check results and any information disclosed by the prospective Board member shall be provided to the Board members in advance of such vote. If a prospective Board member is running for election by another constituency, any results of the background check and any information disclosed by the prospective Board member related to covered offenses occurring within the past ten years shall be (and information on older or other offenses may be, as directed by the Academy Board) made available to those voting, reasonably in advance of such vote. The Academy shall provide in its articles, bylaws or otherwise that the Academy Board has the power to remove any Board member who fails to provide required disclosures or accurate identifying information.
